The organization will also facilitate the inspection of the programme by an officer of the Ministry or any other person authorized by the Ministry. The organization must ensure that the inspection takes place during the currency of the programme. Inspection conducted after completion of the programme will not be recognized by the Ministry.
- (j) The PAC while deciding the G-I-A shall also decide whether the grant will be given in lump-sum or in installment and in the later case the proportion to be given in the installment will also be decided by the PAC.
- (k)The grants-in-aid whether given in installment or lump-sum shall be settled with in the financial year in which it is released.
- (I) All the grantees shall follow the provisions contained in Government of India's General Financial Rules, 2005, wherever applicable.
