Subject: Engagement of a Research Officer for National Sports Development Fund (NSDF) in the Department of Sports

Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports (Department of Sports), Government of India propose to engage a 'Research Officer' for National Sports Development Fund (NSDF) in the Department on contractual basis.

2. The Research Officer will assist 'Target Olympic Podium (TOP) Scheme Elite Athlete Identification Committee' in its task for identification and selection of talented potential medal prospects for 2016 and 2020 Olympic Games. He will also provide research inputs on sportspersons, institutions etc. to the NSDF Cell as and when required. The assignment includes the following:

- a) To make extensive study/research to identify potential young sportspersons in different sports disciplines that should include performance details at international/national/state levels
- b) To make comparative study/analysis with the performance of sportspersons (both accomplished and young) in other countries; also to collect general details of the preparations of such sportspersons;
- c) To assist the Department/Expert Committee in identifying reputed Institutes/Coaches having world class facilities and excellent support personnel for sending our sportspersons for training; also to make analysis of the reasonableness of the rates of coaching fee and other components;
- d) To assist the 'Implementation Committee' under the TOP Scheme, being constituted, in performance evaluation of the selected sportspersons;
- e) To devise systems, standards and bench-marks for performance in major competitions;
- f) To generate quarterly, half yearly and annual reports of the athletes being supported;
- g) To assist the NSDF Secretariat in providing inputs on the performance of sportspersons and academies/organizations being assisted under the scheme; and
- h) To attend any other tasks connected with the above as assigned by the Department of Sports/NSDF Secretariat.

3. The candidate should have the following minimum qualifications and experience:

- 1) Graduate from a reputed Institute in Engineering or Statistics or Mathematics or analytics field;
- 2) Minimum two years experience in sports analytics sector preferably having covered top athletes in Olympics disciplines;

- 3) Deep interest in sports & games and good knowledge of Olympics sports disciplines and Indian athletes; and
- 4) Excellent IT skills

4. The engagement will be initially for a period of one year on contractual basis, which can be extended on yearly basis till the completion of the task subject to review of performance; the remuneration will be in the range of Rs 70,000.00 to 90,000.00.
