The information pertaining to important issues / developments in respect of the Department of Sports during the month of May, 2018 is as follows:

1. **Shooting as a part of 2022 Commonwealth Games:**

Union Sports Minister has urged the Secretary of State for digital, culture, media and sport of United Kingdom (Mr. MP Matt Hancock) for his immediate intervention to ensure that Shooting remains part of the 2022 edition of the Commonwealth Games. The issue was raised on 11.05.2018 when the Visiting dignitary met the Union Sports Minister at New Delhi.

2. **Financial Assistance to Manipuri Fencer, Kh. Kalambia Chanu:**

Under the Pandit Deendayal Upadhyay National Welfare Fund for Sportspersons (PDUNWFS) Scheme, the Union Sports Minister has sanctioned financial assistance of Rs. 5.00 Lakh (Five Lakh) to Fencer Ms. Kh. Kalambia Chanu of Manipur for her medical treatment on 31.5.2018. Ms. Chanu is suffering from multiple Sclerosis and could not continue her sports and living in indigent conditions.
