# MINUTES OF THE 1<sup>ST</sup> DEPARTMENTAL COMMITTEE MEETING FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR 2010-11 HELD ON 7-4-2010

The proposals considered by the Committee and the recommendations made by it are as under:-

#### Agenda No. 1 & 2

Tennis –Proposal for participation in Junior Davis Cup 2010 Asia/Oceana Zone for boys & girls at Kuching Sarawak (Malaysia) from 19-26<sup>th</sup> April, 2010 (F. 37-13/2009-SP.I & F. 37-14/2009-SP.I)

This is a mandatory event hence would not count towards other exposures. The section has submitted two proposals (one for boys & one for girls) for the same event at same place and during same dates. The Committee instructed that the two be merged to form one proposal. The team consists of 6 players (3 boys & 3 girls and 2 coaches. The selection of the players has been done on the basis of past performance and national ranking. The SAI's representative informed that the event is included in the LTDP and Asian Games-2010 Plan for preparation of teams. The Government Observer has agreed to the selection. The likely expenditure of the visit is Rs. 4,21,200/- + Visa fee, insurance, airport tax etc.. The Committee, therefore recommended visit of 6 players and 2 coaches at full cost to the Government as per details given below:

#### Agenda No. 4

Atya Patya – Holding of 19<sup>th</sup> Boys & 12<sup>th</sup> Girls Sub-Junior national Championship at Hyderabad from 1-5<sup>th</sup> May, 2010 (No. 71-5/2009-SP.I)

The proposal for conducting 19<sup>th</sup> Boys & 12<sup>th</sup> Girls Sub-Junior national Championship at Hyderabad from 1-5<sup>th</sup> May, 2010 was considered. The Federation is eligible for an assistance of Rs. 6.00 lakh for the purpose. As there are no UCs pending against the federation, the Committee recommended the proposal for an assistance of Rs.6.00 lakh and release of 75% advance.

# Agenda No. 5

Baseball – Holding of  $20^{th}$  Boys & Girls Sub-Junior national Championship at Goa from 1-5<sup>th</sup> May, 2010 (No. 78-13/2009-SP.I)

The proposal for conducting 20<sup>th</sup> Boys & Girls Sub-Junior national Championship at Goa from 1-5<sup>th</sup> May, 2010 was considered. The Federation is eligible for an assistance of Rs. 6.00 lakh for the purpose. As there are no UCs pending against the federation, the Committee recommended the proposal for an assistance of Rs.6.00 lakh and release of 75% advance.

### Agenda No. 6

Tennis Ball Cricket - Holding of  $17^{th}$  Junior national (Boys & Girls) Championship at Faizabad (UP) from  $13-16^{th}$  June, 2010 (No. 88-7/2009-SP.I)

The proposal for conducting 17<sup>th</sup> Junior national (Boys & Girls) Championship at Faizabad (UP) from 13-16<sup>th</sup> June, 2010 was considered. The Federation is eligible for an assistance of Rs. 4.00 lakh for the purpose. As there are no UCs pending against the federation, the Committee recommended the proposal for an assistance of Rs. 4.00 lakh and release of 75% advance.

#### Agenda No. 7

Baseball - Holding of  $7^{th}$  East Zone Championship at Guwahati (Assam) from  $23-25^{th}$  April, 2010 (No. 78-11/2009-SP.I)

The proposal for conducting 7<sup>th</sup> East Zone Championship at Guwahati (Assam) from 23-25<sup>th</sup> April, 2010 was considered. The Federation is eligible for an assistance of Rs. 1.00 lakh for the purpose. As there are no UCs pending against the federation, the Committee recommended the proposal for an assistance of Rs.1.00 lakh and release of 75% advance.

#### Agenda No. 8

Sepaktakraw – Holding of 20<sup>th</sup> Senior national (Boys & Girls) Championship at Delhi from 29<sup>th</sup> Dec, 2009 to 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2010 (No. 92-4/2009-SP.I)

The proposal for conducting 20<sup>th</sup> Senior national (Boys & Girls) Championship at Delhi from 29<sup>th</sup> Dec, 2009 to 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2010 was considered. The Committee noted that this was earlier considered and the federation was asked to furnish some documents which were later furnished by them but it could not be placed before the Committee. The Committee, therefore, instructed that the same be now considered after receipt of accounts, reports etc. of the event.

# Agenda No. 9

Sepaktakraw – Holding of 14<sup>th</sup> Junior national (Boys & Girls) Championship at Calicut (Kerala) from 2-5<sup>th</sup> May, 2010 (No. 92-6/2009-SP.I)

The proposal for conducting 14<sup>th</sup> Junior national (Boys & Girls) Championship at Calicut (Kerala) from 2-5<sup>th</sup> May, 2010 was considered. The Federation is eligible for an assistance of Rs. 2.00 lakh for the purpose. As there are no UCs pending against the federation, the Committee recommended the proposal for an assistance of Rs. 2.00 lakh and release of 75% advance.

#### Agenda No. 10

The proposal for conducting 1<sup>st</sup> India Open Taekwondo International Championship-2010 at Bangalore (Karnataka) from 7-9<sup>th</sup> May, 2010 was not considered by the Committee as the federation has not been granted annual recognition for 2010 for want of valid Registration Certificate.

The SAI's representative informed that the event is included in the LTDP and Asian Games-2010 Plan for preparation of teams. The Government Observer has agreed to the selection. The Committee noted that the federation has already submitted documents for renewal of recognition which are being examined. The Committee, therefore recommended visit of 8 players and 2 coaches at full cost to the Government as per details given below:
