**MINUTES OF THE 1ST DEPARTMENTAL COMMITTEE MEETING
FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR 2010-11 HELD ON 7-4-2010**

A meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Shri Injeti Srinivas, Joint Secretary (Sports). The following Members were present in the meeting

Shri Bhattacharya, SO (SP-I), Shri K.K. Paul, SO (SP.II) and Shri B.S. Kakkar SO (SP.III) were present to assist the Committee.

The proposals considered by the Committee and the recommendations made by it are as under:-

Agenda No. 1 & 2

Tennis –Proposal for participation in Junior Davis Cup 2010 Asia/Oceania Zone for boys & girls at Kuching Sarawak (Malaysia) from 19-26th April, 2010 (F. 37-13/2009-SP.I & F. 37-14/2009-SP.I)

This is a mandatory event hence would not count towards other exposures. The section has submitted two proposals (one for boys & one for girls) for the same event at same place and during same dates. The Committee instructed that the two be merged to form one proposal. The team consists of 6 players (3 boys & 3 girls and 2 coaches. The selection of the players has been done on the basis of past performance and national ranking. The SAI's representative informed that the event is included in the LTDP and Asian Games-2010 Plan for preparation of teams. The Government Observer has agreed to the selection. The likely expenditure of the visit is Rs. 4,21,200/- + Visa fee, insurance, airport tax etc.. The Committee, therefore recommended visit of 6 players and 2 coaches at full cost to the Government as per details given below:

1.	Air Passage cost for 8 persons (6 players and 2 coaches) for the sector Home Town-Delhi-Kuching-Delhi-Hometown. The estimate is on the basis of full fare economy class and the federation would be advised to procure the cheapest available fare in excursion class, visa fees, airport tax, insurance will be as per actual.	Rs. 3,20,000/- @ Rs 40,000/- per head for 8 persons + Visa fee, airport tax, Insurance as per actual
2.	Gutting of rackets for 6 players @ USD 100 per player	USD 600 = Rs. 27,600/- (At the conversion rate of 1 USD = Rs. 46/-)
3.	Out of pocket allowance @ USD 20 per head per day for 10 days for 8 persons	USD 1600 = Rs. 73,600/-(At the conversion rate of 1 USD = Rs. 46/-)

Agenda No. 3

Basketball – Holding of qualifying round of Middle Asia Zone for men at Bangalore from 16-18th April, 2010 (No. 16-2/2010-SP.I)

The proposal for conducting **qualifying round of Middle Asia Zone for men at Bangalore from 16-18th April, 2010** was considered. The Federation is eligible for an assistance of Rs. 6.00 lakh for the purpose. As there are no UCs pending against the federation, the Committee recommended the proposal for an assistance of Rs.6.00 lakh and release of 75% advance.

Agenda No. 4

Atya Patya – Holding of 19th Boys & 12th Girls Sub-Junior national Championship at Hyderabad from 1-5th May, 2010 (No. 71-5/2009-SP.I)

The proposal for conducting **19th Boys & 12th Girls Sub-Junior national Championship at Hyderabad from 1-5th May, 2010** was considered. The Federation is eligible for an assistance of Rs. 6.00 lakh for the purpose. As there are no UCs pending against the federation, the Committee recommended the proposal for an assistance of Rs.6.00 lakh and release of 75% advance.

Agenda No. 5

Baseball – Holding of 20th Boys & Girls Sub-Junior national Championship at Goa from 1-5th May, 2010 (No. 78-13/2009-SP.I)

The proposal for conducting **20th Boys & Girls Sub-Junior national Championship at Goa from 1-5th May, 2010** was considered. The Federation is eligible for an assistance of Rs. 6.00 lakh for the purpose. As there are no UCs pending against the federation, the Committee recommended the proposal for an assistance of Rs.6.00 lakh and release of 75% advance.

Agenda No. 6

Tennis Ball Cricket – Holding of 17th Junior national (Boys & Girls) Championship at Faizabad (UP) from 13-16th June, 2010 (No. 88-7/2009-SP.I)

The proposal for conducting **17th Junior national (Boys & Girls) Championship at Faizabad (UP) from 13-16th June, 2010** was considered. The Federation is eligible for an assistance of Rs. 4.00 lakh for the purpose. As there are no UCs pending against the federation, the Committee recommended the proposal for an assistance of Rs. 4.00 lakh and release of 75% advance.

Agenda No. 7

Baseball – Holding of 7th East Zone Championship at Guwahati (Assam) from 23-25th April, 2010 (No. 78-11/2009-SP.I)

The proposal for conducting **7th East Zone Championship at Guwahati (Assam) from 23-25th April, 2010** was considered. The Federation is eligible for an assistance of Rs. 1.00 lakh for the purpose. As there are no UCs pending against the federation, the Committee recommended the proposal for an assistance of Rs.1.00 lakh and release of 75% advance.

Agenda No. 8

Sepaktakraw – Holding of 20th Senior national (Boys & Girls) Championship at Delhi from 29th Dec, 2009 to 1st January, 2010 (No. 92-4/2009-SP.I)

The proposal for conducting **20th Senior national (Boys & Girls) Championship at Delhi from 29th Dec, 2009 to 1st January, 2010** was considered. The Committee noted that this was earlier considered and the federation was asked to furnish some documents which were later furnished by them but it could not be placed before the Committee. The Committee, therefore, instructed that the same be now considered after receipt of accounts, reports etc. of the event.

Agenda No. 9

Sepaktakraw – Holding of 14th Junior national (Boys & Girls) Championship at Calicut (Kerala) from 2-5th May, 2010 (No. 92-6/2009-SP.I)

The proposal for conducting **14th Junior national (Boys & Girls) Championship at Calicut (Kerala) from 2-5th May, 2010** was considered. The Federation is eligible for an assistance of Rs. 2.00 lakh for the purpose. As there are no UCs pending against the federation, the Committee recommended the proposal for an assistance of Rs. 2.00 lakh and release of 75% advance.

Agenda No. 10

Taekwondo – Holding of 1st India Open Taekwondo International Championship-2010 at Bangalore (Karnataka) from 7-9th May, 2010 (No. 72-17/2009-SP.I)

The proposal for conducting **1st India Open Taekwondo International Championship-2010 at Bangalore (Karnataka) from 7-9th May, 2010** was not considered by the Committee as the federation has not been granted annual recognition for 2010 for want of valid Registration Certificate.

Supplementary Agenda No. 1

Badminton –Proposal for participation in Junior World Badminton Championship-2010 at Jalisco (Mexico) from 16-25th April, 2010 (F. 14-2/2010-SP.III)

This is a mandatory event hence would not count towards other exposures. The team consists of 8 players (4 boys & 4 girls) and 2 coaches. The selection of the players has been done on the basis of past performance and national ranking. The SAI's representative informed that the event is included in the LTDP and Asian Games-2010 Plan for preparation of teams. The Government Observer has agreed to the selection. The likely expenditure of the visit is Rs. 32,72,000/- + Visa fee, insurance, airport tax etc.. The Committee noted that the federation has already submitted documents for renewal of recognition which are being examined. The Committee, therefore recommended visit of 8 players and 2 coaches at full cost to the Government as per details given below:

1.	Air Passage cost for 10 persons (8 players and 2 coaches) for the sector Hyderabad/Bangalore-Jalisco (Mexico)-Home Towns. The estimate is on the basis of full fare economy class and the federation would be advised to procure the cheapest available fare in excursion class, visa fees, airport tax, insurance will be as per actual.	Rs25,00,000/- @ Rs 2,50,000/- per head for 10 persons + Visa fee, airport tax, Insurance as per actual
2.	Accommodation: 5 Double rooms @ USD 180 per room per day for 12 days = USD 10,800	USD 10,800 = Rs. 4,96,000/- (At the conversion rate of 1 USD = Rs. 46/-)
3.	Food Expenses @ USD 25 per head per day for 10 persons for 12 days = USD 3000	USD 3000 = Rs. 1,38,000/- (At the conversion rate of 1 USD = Rs. 46/-)
4.	Out of Pocket Allowance @ USD 25 per persons per day for 10 persons for 12 days = USD 3000	USD 3000 = Rs. 1,38,000/- (At the conversion rate of 1 USD = Rs. 46/-)

Supplementary Agenda No. 2

Golf – Holding of Asia Pacific Junior Golf Championship at Bangalore from 13-16th May, 2010 (No. 29-6/2010-SP.III)

The proposal for conducting **Asia Pacific Junior Golf Championship at Bangalore from 13-16th May, 2010** was considered. The Federation is eligible for an assistance of Rs. 6.00 lakh for the purpose. As there are no UCs pending against the federation, the Committee recommended the proposal for an assistance of Rs.6.00 lakh and release of 75% advance.

Supplementary Agenda No. 3

Billiards & Snooker–Proposal for participation in 26th Asian Snooker Championship-2010 at Chanthaburi (Thailand) from 8-15th May, 2010 (F. 17-3/2010-SP.II)

This is a mandatory event hence would not count towards other exposures. The team consists of 2 players and 1 coach. The selection of the players has been done on the basis of past performance and national ranking. The SAI's representative informed that the event is included in the LTDP. The Government Observer has agreed to the selection. The likely expenditure of the visit is Rs. 2,10,800/- + Visa fee, insurance, airport tax etc.. The Committee, therefore recommended visit of 2 players and 1 coaches at full cost to the Government as per details given below:

1.	Air Passage cost for 3 persons (2 players and 1 coach) for the sector Mumbai/Bangalore-Chanthaburi-Home Towns. The estimate is on the basis of full fare economy class and the federation would be advised to procure the cheapest available fare in excursion class, visa fees, airport tax, insurance will be as per actual.	Rs. 1,05,000/- @ Rs 35,000/- per head for 3 persons + Visa fee, airport tax, Insurance as per actual
2.	Accommodation with breakfast @ USD 50 per head per day for 9 days = USD 1350	USD 1350 = Rs. 62,100/- (At the conversion rate of 1 USD = Rs. 46/-)
3.	Food Expenses @ USD 30 per head per day for 3 persons for 9 days = USD 810	USD 810 = Rs. 37,260/- (At the conversion rate of 1 USD = Rs. 46/-)
4.	Practice charges for 2 players for 7 days @ USD 10 per head per day = USD 140	USD 140 = Rs. 6440/- (At the conversion rate of 1 USD = Rs. 46/-)

Supplementary Agenda No. 4 & 5

Weightlifting – Holding of 47th Men & 23rd Women Junior national Championship at Yamuna Nagar (Haryana) from 26-29th June, 2010 (No. 49-5/2010-SP.II) and 6th National Sub-junior Youth Championship from 20-24th June, 2010.

The proposal for conducting **6th National Sub-Junior Championship from 20-24th June, 2010 & 47th Men & 23rd Women Junior national Championship at Yamuna Nagar (Haryana) from 26-29th June, 2010** was considered. The Federation is eligible for an assistance of Rs. 10.00 lakh for the purpose. As there are no UCs pending against the federation, the Committee recommended the proposal for an assistance of Rs. 10.00 lakh and release of 75% advance and desired that organizers be advised to conduct thorough dope tests at the event.
