Subject :- Clarifications to Tender Reference No. F.No. 14-179/2016 SPIV CDN and Tender ID 2017_SPORT_223262_1 regarding Tender for preparing Tableau of Department of Sports for Republic Day Parade, 2018.

Following clarifications / modifications / additions are made in the tender document. All other clauses of the tender document remain unchanged.

A) Information Sheet – Page 1 of the tender document.

- (i) Bid submission closing date & time has been modified from 28.07.2017 at 1400 Hrs to 14.08.2017 at 1400 Hrs**
- (ii) Technical Bid opening date, time & venue has been modified from 29.07.2017 at 1400 Hrs to 16.08.2017 at 1400 Hrs. Venue will be the same.**

B) Following additions have been made in Scope of Work

3.8 The sketch / design is to be drawn on a scale of 1 feet to 1 inch scale. It should be simple, colourful, easy to comprehend and should avoid statistical data and unnecessary details. It should be able to convey, whatever it presents by itself and should not require any explanation, writing or elaboration. Writing or use of logos on tableau is not allowed except the name of the Ministry /Department is to be given in Hindi in the front and in English on the back.

3.9 The number of performers on the tableau would not be more than 10 persons. No performer is permitted to be on the tractor component of the tableau. Attractive ground element however can be considered on a limited number of tableau only if it goes with the theme.

3.10 Camouflaging the tractor should be in harmony with the main theme of the tableau. There should be a gap of 6-7 feet between the tractor and the trailer and/or between two trailers for turning or manoeuvring. This should be taken into account while designing tableau.

3.11 While preparing the sketches and subsequently, three dimensional models, the following approximate dimensions of the trailers and tractors may be kept in view:

<u>Trailer</u>	
Length	: 24' 8"
Width	: 8'
Height	: 4' 2"
Load carrying capacity:	10 tons

The length breadth and height of a single tableau should not exceed 45', 14' and 16' (from the ground level) respectively. One Trailer and one tractor will be provided by Ministry of defence free of charge. Tableau is to be made using that only.

3.12 The 'theme' for designing the tableau will be "Khelo India" & salient features of the 'theme' have been attached as Appendix.

C) Para 6.1 (m) is replaced as follows :-

Artistic drawings of upto 3 drawings as per size stated in the scope of work proposed for the tableau for this tender (refer paras 3.8, 3.11 & 3.12).

D) Sl. No. 25 in Annexure II is replaced as follows :-

Artistic drawings upto 3 drawings proposed for the tableau for this tender.

F) In Annexure V 40% weightage will be given to Financial Bid is to be read as 30% weightage will be given to Financial Bid.

G) In para 7 regarding evaluation of Bid, the words “ 60 % weightage will be given for technical bid and 40% weightage will be given for financial bid “ are replaced by the following

“70 % weightage will be given for technical bid and 30% weightage will be given for financial bid”

& the words “The financial bid in respect of the successful technical bid only will be opened” are replaced by the following :-

“ The financial bid in respect of the successful technical bidders (i.e. eligible and responsive bidders) only will be opened”

H) In para 6.1 relating to Submission of documents in technical bid para 6.1 (h) (i) regarding annual turnover stands deleted.

I) In para 6.1 relating to Submission of documents in technical bid para 6.1 (d) the words “or any such national / international function / festival ” stand deleted.

J) In Annexure II i.e. check list Sl. No. 14 the words “or any such national / international function / festival ” stand deleted.

K) In para 6.1 relating to Submission of documents in technical bid para 6.1 (e) the sentence “Solvency certificate should be from a chartered accountant” is added at the end.

L) In para 6.1 relating to Submission of documents in technical bid para 6.1 (l) is replaced as follows:-

“Scanned copy of Clarifications issued by MYAS to this tender, if any, duly signed and stamped on each page by the authorized signatory of the bidder as a mark of acceptance of all conditions of the tender. ”

M) Sl. 13 in Annexure II – Check list is replaced as follows :- “Annexure-VII (Tender Acceptance letter) and scanned copy of clarifications issued by MYAS to this tender, if any, duly signed and stamped on each page by the authorized signatory of the bidder as a mark of acceptance of all conditions of the tender”.

N) In Annexure II i.e. check list Sl. No. 16 (i) regarding annual turnover stands deleted.

O) Copy of EMD, Tender fees and Artistic drawings are to be uploaded. original EMD, Tender fees & drawings are to be submitted to Under Secretary (Coordination) at the address stated in the Information sheet. It is the responsibility of the bidder that the said officer receives the said documents before the closing date and time for submission of the Bid. Pass required for entering the building may be requested for from the said officer.

P) A new clause 15.19 is added as follows :-

This Ministry will prescribe timelines for completion various stages of work stage wise. Successful bidder will strictly adhere to the said timelines. In case of delay in completion of work as per the requirements of MYAS for any stages of the work, liquidated damage will be imposed and bidder will be banned for participating in future tender of MYAS. The liquidated damages will be imposed @ 2.4% of the total work order per day upto a maximum delay of 5 days. For delay beyond 5 days the work order is liable to be cancelled and Performance Bank Guarantee is liable to be

encashed. Further in such case, payments made to the bidder for 3rd and 4th instalments as per Annexure VI, if any, will also have to be refunded by the bidder within 30 days of cancellation of work order.

- Q) A new clause 15.20 is added as follows :- The successful bidder will have to sign a contract with MYAS for award of work.**
- R) In Annexure III Sl. No. 11 and 12 stand deleted.**
- S) In Annexure II – check list Sl. No. 17 is replaced as follows “Signed and scanned copy of audited statement of Accounts of the bidding organization and annual report for the years 2014 – 15 and 2015-16. Audited accounts and report prior to 2014-15 will not be accepted”**
- T) In para 2(vii) the figure “4” is replaced by figure “5”.**

Theme for the Tableau

The theme for the Tableau will be Khelo India scheme of Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Govt. of India.

Objective of the scheme

The scheme aims to achieve the twin objectives of the National Sports Policy 2001- broad basing of sports and achieving excellence in sports, which in turn will infuse sports culture in the country, thus allowing the population to derive benefits that sports offers through its cross-cutting influence, namely, holistic development of children & youth, community development, gender equity, national integration and nation building, healthy lifestyle, national pride and economic opportunities related to sport development.

Components of the scheme

- i. Play Fields Development
- ii. Community Coaching Development
- iii. State Level Khelo India Centres
- iv. Annual Sports Competitions
- v. Talent Search & Development
- vi. Creation/ Upgradation of Sports Infrastructure
- vii. Support to National/Regional/State Sports Academies
- viii. Physical Fitness of School going Children
- ix. Sports for Women
- x. Sports for Peace and Development
- xi. Promotion of Sports among persons with disabilities
- xii. Promotion of rural and indigenous/tribal games

Play Field Development:-

Playfields will be developed in all parts of the country. A National inventory of playfields and sports infrastructure will be prepared on a Geographic Information System (GIS) platform for dissemination of information about them and ensure their optimum utilisation. The existing and developed play fields will be Geo-tagged and displayed in public domain for knowledge and use of the general public at large.

Community Coaching Development:

A cascading model of Community Coach Development will be adopted for development of community coaches across the country. In order to put into place a mechanism to build capacity of these coaches, a community coaching development programme will be evolved. All PETs (Physical Education Teachers)/Volunteers will be trained as community coaches. Online courses for community coach development will also be developed and put on public domain for interested persons.

State Level Khelo India Centres :

State Level Khelo India Centres will be set up by providing coaches/part-time coaches, equipment, proper field of play, consumables, day boarding facilities, physiotherapists, etc.,. The sports infrastructure facilities available in the State will be better utilized through a suitable Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) as per the norms of Sports Authority of India (SAI).

Annual Sports Competitions:

The following National level competitions will be organized in respect of priority sports discipline at various places across the country :

- i. Khelo India National School Games
- ii. Khelo India National University Games

Every effort will be made to strengthen sports in school campuses as well as college and University campuses in the country under Khelo India Scheme by involving more and more schools and Universities in these competitions.

Talent Identification and Development :-

The National competitions involving schools, colleges, Universities and National Sports Federations (NSFs) under Khelo India Scheme, National Championships, and National Sports Talent Search Portal of SAI, will provide a platform for identification of talented sports persons in priority Sports disciplines in which the country has potential/advantage. The identified best talented sportspersons will be provided annual financial assistance under a long term athlete development programme.

Creation/Upgradation of Sports Infrastructure :-

Sports infrastructure facilities like synthetic athletic track, synthetic hockey field, football turf, construction of multi-purpose indoor hall, swimming pool, up-gradation/renovation of existing sports infrastructure etc., will be established. It is proposed to set up four universities centre of excellence per annum. These centres will cater to both university athlete as well as athletes.

Support to National/ Regional/State Sports Academies:-

The identified talented sportspersons will be given the option to join SAI National Sports Academies, State Sports Academies or Sports Academies established by private sector. Grants in aid will be provided for establishment, operation and maintenance of sports academies in respect of identified disciplines to Sports Authority of India, State Governments or to private sector or sports person under PPP mode for facilitating and supplementing Long Term Athlete Development (LTAD) programme.

Physical Fitness:-

An effort will be made to implement a component of physical fitness across all schools in India. A tool kit will be provided to each school to evaluate physical fitness of all school going children. This tool kit would be easy to implement by physical education teacher or any subject teacher with the help of guidelines included in the kit. Sports will be integrated with School education by making it a compulsory subject for which marks will be awarded.

Sports for Women:-

While all the components of the Khelo India Scheme are gender neutral and afford opportunities to women too for participating in sporting activities and development of sports, it is proposed to hold annual national competitions for women. Emphasis will be laid on such sports disciplines where there is less participation of women so that more number of women will participate in such sports disciplines.

Sports for Peace & Development:-

The Government of India, under the Special Package for Jammu & Kashmir is providing funds to the tune of Rs.200 crore for enhancement of sports facilities in the State. To ensure optimal utilization of these infrastructure, soft support in terms of coaches, equipment, consumables, technical support, competition etc. will be provided. Efforts will be made to organise village level competitions in respect of sports disciplines popular in the State of J&K for positive engagement of youth. Similar efforts will also be made in case of other extremism and terrorism affected and other disturbed areas.

Promotion of sports among persons with disabilities:-

Financial assistance will be provided to States/UTs and SAI for creation of specialist sports infrastructure for persons with disabilities. Funds will be provided for making stadia disabled friendly / barrier free.

Promotion of rural and indigenous/tribal games:-

Sports competitions will be held annually under the Khelo India Scheme in rural and indigenous/tribal games alternately. A dynamic and interactive website providing information on such games will also be put up. This will not only help disseminate information and pique the curiosity of the present generation about these games but also encourage children and youth to take up these games in a major way, paving way for their future mainstreaming.

Priority sports disciplines:-

Archery, Athletics, Badminton, Basketball, Boxing, Chess, Cycling, Football, Gymnastics, Handball, Hockey, Judo, Kabaddi, Karate, Kho-Kho, Shooting, Swimming, Table Tennis, Taekwondo, Tennis, Volleyball, Weightlifting, Wrestling and Wushu.
