There is a need to promote Sports Science in the country so as to integrate the said knowledge / expertise with training of athletes for achieving excellence in sports. - (ii) In case of Government University/institution, 75% of the total estimated cost will be from the Ministry and remaining 25% will have to be spent/arranged by the university. The same is applicable both for capital expenditure and Operational expenditure.
