Monthly Report for the month of December, 2023

Name of the Ministry / Department: Department of Sports

1. Important policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:

- a) The first-ever Khelo India Para Games were held between 10th and 17th December, 2023 in New Delhi. The event saw a participation of over 1450 para-athletes from 32 States/UTs in seven sports disciplines. Haryana finished 1st in the medal tally with 105 Medals, including 40 Gold Medals, followed by Uttar Pradesh with 62 Medals (including 25 Gold) and Tamil Nadu with 42 Medals (including 20 Gold).
- b) Under the "President with the People" programme, 28 talented athletes from various sports disciplines got an opportunity to interact with the Hon'ble President at Rashtrapati Bhavan. The interaction comprised of the role of the athletes in bringing glory to the nation through their performance on the international stage, athletes as the ambassador of culture, values and spirit of India.
- c) To strengthen the sports science ecosystem of the country, a two-day Sports Science conclave was organized by the National Center for Sports Science and Research (NCSSR) on 13th & 14th December 2023, on the sidelines of the Khelo India Para Games. The Conclave served as an enabling platform for various stakeholders to collaborate in creating a strong sports science landscape for Indian athletes.
- d) The 6th edition of Khelo India Youth Games (KIYG) is being held from 19th January and 31st January, 2024 in four cities of Tamil Nadu namely, Chennai, Trichy, Madurai, and Coimbatore. The official logo, jersey, mascot, torch and theme song for the 6th edition of KIYG were launched on 22nd December, 2023 in Chennai, Tamil Nadu.
- e) On 23rd December, 2023, various facilities that were under development at Sports Authority of India (SAI) Regional Centre in Bengaluru were dedicated to the athletes including two hostel buildings (A 330 bedded Hostel for women and a 300 bedded Hostel for men) and a Synthetic Athletic track.
- f) National Anti-Doping Agency (NADA) organized a total of 17 Anti-Doping Education Awareness programmes across the country during the month.
- g) The Preliminary rounds of 3rd edition of Fit India Quiz were conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA) on 21st & 22nd December 2023.
- h) The 118th Meeting of Mission Olympics Cell (MOC) was held on 13-14.12.2023 on various components of TOPS. Proposals from various athletes belonging to various sporting disciplines worth Rs. 37.20 Lakhs were approved.
- i) Various activities have been carried out under the Annual Capacity Building Plan by this Department. Under this initiative, a training session on the Prevention of Sexual Harassment Act was organized for the Department Officials on 22.12.2023.

- a) National Dope Testing Laboratory (NDTL) organised various activities on Swachhta Abhiyan during December, 2023. All the officials regularly dedicate an hour of their time to "Shram Daan" for the Garbage Free India initiative.
- b) Swachhta Campaigns were organized in the office premises of the National Anti-Doping Agency (NADA), the Sports Authority of India (SAI) Head Office and SAI Regional Centres across the country with the active participation of the staff.
- c) Cleanliness drives are regularly organised at Lakshmibai National Institute of Physical Education (LNIPE) under the Swachhta Abhiyan.
- 6. Status of Rationalization of Autonomous Bodies:

Does not arise in the case of D/o Sports as all the five Autonomous Bodies- SAI, LNIPE, National Sports University (NSU), NADA and NDTL have been set up for specific purposes.
