Monthly Report for the month of May, 2024

Name of the Ministry / Department: Department of Sports

1. Important policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:

- a) Key sporting achievements of Indian athletes in May include the Indian Boxing Contingent finishing the Asian Boxing Confederation Championships held in Astana, Kazakhstan, with 43 Medals (12 Gold, 14 Silver and 17 Bronze Medals) in the Youth and Under-22 Categories. India finished with the second-highest medal count, only behind the hosts, Kazakhstan, who won 48 medals. India finished the World Para-Athletic Championship (Kobe, Japan) with its best-ever Medal Tally, winning 17 Medals (6 Gold, 5 Silver and 6 Bronze Medals), finishing 6th in the overall medals tally. Ms.Dipa Karmakar became the first India Gymnast to win a Gold Medal in the Asian Gymnastics Championships held in Tashkent, Uzbekistan.
- b) As a part of the ASMITA Women's Leagues, to encourage the participation of women in sports, 02 football leagues were organized in Manipur and New Delhi.
- c) The development of the sports personnel ecosystem is a key contributing factor to the overall development of the sports industry in India. As a part of this, a certification program in Sports Psychology for Shooting Sports was organised between 20th and 24th May in Delhi, by the National Centre for Sports Science and Research in collaboration with the National Rifle Association of India.
- d) The "Fitness Ki Baat Champions Ke Sath" podcast series has been showcasing inspiring stories of the sporting heroes of India. In May 2024, podcasts featuring Arjuna Award-winning Golfer Diksha Dagar and famous woman boxer Neetu Ghanghas were broadcast on various platforms. Through the journey of these athletes, the podcast series is expected to inspire the audience to lead a healthy and physically active lifestyle.
- e) Under the Annual Capacity Building Plan, various activities have been carried out by this Department. Under this initiative, training sessions on the Prevention of Sexual Harassment Act, 2013 and Navigating Legal Aspects of Sports were organized for the Department Officials and various stakeholders on 13.05.2024 and 20.05.2024 respectively.
- f) The National Anti-Doping Agency (NADA) organized 22 Anti-Doping Education Awareness programmes across the country in the month of May.
- g) The 134th, 135th, 136th, 137th and 138th Meeting of Mission Olympics Cell (MOC) were held on 02.05.2024, 09.05.2024, 16.05.2024, 25.05.2024 and 30.05.2024 respectively on various components of Target Olympic Podium Scheme (TOPS). Proposals from various athletes of different sporting disciplines worth Rs. 3,54,46,703 were approved.

- b) Under the Swachhta Campaign, the office premises of NADA including workstations, electrical and Dope-kit rooms are regularly cleaned with the active involvement of the staff.
- c) The Swachhta Campaign is actively carried out at the Lakshmibai National Institute of Physical Education (LNIPE) thus ensuring the cleanliness and hygiene of the campus.
