4. The participation of 32 sportspersons, 9 support personnel, will be at cost to the Government. IOA will bear the cost for the travel of Chef-de-Mission as informed by them.
5. Expenditure on air travel (economy class) and sports kit, if any, as decided in the meeting dated 13.6.2017 will be borne by Sports Authority of India (SAI) for the funds made available to it under the Scheme of Assistance to NSFs.
6. Section 9 of Foreign Contribution Regulation Act, 2010 provides inter alia that no member of a Legislature, Office bearer of a political party, judge, Government servant or employee, of any corporation shall accept any foreign hospitality without the prior permission of the Central Government. In case any team member is covered under the above Act, he/she should obtain the prior permission from Ministry of Home Affairs before his/her departure to China.
7. Since the organizers are making arrangement for Boarding & Lodging & transport, 25% of DA is payable. Hence, DA@ 25 USD per person per day may be paid from 16.6.2017 to 21.06.2017. SAI will make arrangements for payment of DA.
8. It is requested that Embassy of India in China and organizers of the event may please be informed of the travel plans and itinerary of the contingent.
9. In view of the disappearance of some officials/sportspersons in the foreign countries in the past, this Ministry is of the view that the backgrounds/antecedents of the members/officials may be checked properly.
10. A detailed report on the visit of the team along with its performance/achievements and action photographs, CDs etc may please be submitted to the Ministry of youth Affairs & Sports, within 30 days of return of the team to India.

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
