Subject: Renewal of recognition of Billiards and Snooker Federation of India - regd.

Sir,

The matter regarding renewal of recognition to Billiards and Snooker Federation of India has been examined. The last election of office bearers of the Federation was held on 21st June, 2014 for the term 2014-18. The election of the Federation held on 23.03.2019 was not accepted by the Ministry and the Federation was asked to hold fresh elections, which could not be conducted by the Federation so far due to outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic.

2. The matter regarding elections of NSFs which have not been conducted during the country-wide lockdown imposed to contain the spread of COVID-19 pandemic have been looked into by the Ministry. The restrictions imposed are being relaxed in phased manner by re-opening of activities outside the containment zone. Also under the latest guidelines issued by Ministry of Home Affairs social/academic/sports/entertainment/cultural/religious/political functions and other congregations have been permitted with a ceiling of 100 persons. However, directives for COVID-19 management are to be followed mandatorily. In the circumstances, it has been decided that Billiards and Snooker Federation of India shall conduct election of its executive body by 31.12.2020, following the Model Elections guidelines prescribed in the National Sports Development Code 2011.


3. Upon consideration of the entire matter, it has also been decided to renew the recognition of Billiards and Snooker Federation of India up to 31.12.2020.

4. It has been noticed that constitution / MoA of Billiards and Snooker Federation of India needs to be aligned with the provisions of the National Sports Development Code of India, 2011 (Sports Code). Accordingly, the Billiards and Snooker Federation of India is required to make categorical affirmation of the provisions of the Sports Code in its constitution within 6 months so as to bring the same fully in line with the Sports Code. The Federation is also required to take necessary steps for uploading of the information in compliance to the instructions as contained in this Ministry's letter no. 9-7/2014-SP.I dated 26.02.2015 on suo-moto disclosure within 3 months' time (copy enclosed).
