

Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department whenever the institution or organization is called upon to do so.

- (iv) The institution/organizations seeking Grant-in-aid should also certify that it has not obtained or applied for grants for the same purpose or activity from any other Ministry or Department of the Government of India or State Government.
- (v) The Grant-in-aid is further subject to the conditions laid down in General Financial Rules as amended from time to time.
- (vi) The grantee will promote HIV/AIDS Awareness.
- (vii) This is a **non-recurring** grant. The grantee shall submit the Utilization Certificate (UC) in the prescribed format within twelve months of the close of the financial year. The UC should be checked and signed by an officer not below the rank of Director and counter-signed by the Secretary (Sports), Government of Madhya Pradesh. The subsidiary accounts of the Govt. grant shall be maintained by the grantee as per Rule 210 of the GF Rules 2005 included as clause 3 (ii) above. The UC should also disclose whether the specified, quantified and qualitative targets that should have been achieved against the amount utilized, were in fact achieved, and if not the reasons therefor.
- (viii) The fact that the programme is sponsored by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports should be prominently highlighted and displayed while inviting people and holding functions/programmes/events etc.
- (ix) Wherever the Government of India has reasons to believe that the sanctioned money is not being utilized for the approved purposes, the payment of the grant shall be stopped forthwith and a show cause notice will be issued to the grantee. If the reply to the show cause notice is not satisfactory, the earlier grant will be recovered with interest as mentioned in Clause 3 (ii) above.
- (x) It may be ensured that the sanctioned programme(s) is started within one month from the date of the receipt of the funds and the amount of the grant is utilized within a period of three months from the said date.
- (xi) The grantee institution/organization should exercise reasonable economy in the working of approved project.
- (xii) The assets acquired wholly or substantially out of Govt. grant except those declared as obsolete and unserviceable or condemned as per the procedure laid down in the General Financial Rules shall not be disposed of without the prior approval of Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports.
